

Sensorics Exam – WiSe 2021/22 (Prof. O. Nelles)

- **Written Exam**
- **Duration: 2 h**
- **Permitted tools: formular collection, script, pocket calculator**
- **The links for downloading the exam tasks and uploading the solution (sciebo), the link for the zoom-meeting and an email address (for uploading your solution in case sciebo does not work) will be provided 1 week in advance of the exam to your email address.**

Procedure

- Prepare a suitable envelope (e.g. DIN A4), stamp it and address it with:

- **The attendance to the zoom-meeting during the examination is highly recommended.**
- Please join the zoom-meeting using your full name (format: “surname, first name”).
- We provide you with a PDF containing the exam tasks 5 min. in advance of the exam. You can download it from sciebo. Additionally, the exam tasks are distributed via email.
- You have a time period of 120 min. to solve the given tasks on white, quad-ruled paper. Please do not use a pencil. Sign the declaration that you have carried out the task on your own. The declaration form is provided via sciebo.
- During the examination you may ask questions about ambiguities in the exam tasks via the zoom-meeting.
- After the examination time is up you have 15 min. to scan all (!) pages of your solution and upload it (as *single* PDF) to the sciebo folder. In case this does not work, you can send the solution by email.
For scanning the solution by smartphone, the app “Genius Scan – PDF Scanner” is recommended.
The file must be named as follows: “*Sensorics_matriculation number_surname.pdf*”.
Uploaded files and emails which are more than 15 min. late will be ignored. Missing pages cannot be submitted afterwards.
- Send your solution in original inside the envelope together with the declaration to the University at the provided address. Only the scanned copy will be valid in case of doubt.
- Within 5 working days the envelope with solution and declaration has to be processed by the postal service (date stamp).
